## 21 Aug (Thu) Arrive Delhi

This evening, after completion of IT&CM India, you will be transferred to another Delhi hotel, where all other participants of this post tour will be staying for 2 nights.

# 22 Aug (Fri) Discover Delhi (B/L)

08:00 - 09:30 Hrs: Breakfast at hotel. Table reserved for Travelite (India) Group at the hotels all day dining / breakfast restaurant. An opportunity for you to meet and introduce yourselves to other group members

<u>09:45 – 12:00 Hrs</u>: Drive to Old Delhi, passing through the busy streets of Chandni Chowk, arrive at **Jama Masjid**, the largest mosque in India. Take a brief tour of Jama Masjid before noon. Being Friday, the holy day of Islam, expect the place to be busy and crowded.

12:00 - 14:00 Hrs: Lunch with hotel inspection

<u>14:00 – 18:30 Hrs</u>: This afternoon take a sightseeing tour of New Delhi. Visit **Qutab Minar**, a fine example of early Muslim and Afghani architecture in India. Drive past India's seat of power, the **President House** and **Parliament House**. Take a short photo stop at **India Gate**, the famous war memorial arch of India. Then visit the gold tombed **Gurudwara Bangla Sahib**, a live Sikh temple still in active worship. This sacred temple is highly spiritual and the holy water here is believed to have cured many followers of their illness.

Return to your hotel for overnight stay.

### 23 Aug (Sat) Delhi - Agra (205 km /4 hrs) (B/L)

08:00 - 09:30 Hrs: Breakfast at hotel and check out

09:30 - 13:30 Hrs: Drive to Agra.

13:30 - 16:00 Hrs: Arrive Agra. Lunch with brief Hotel Inspection. Then, check in at your hotel and freshen up

<u>16:00 – 17:30 Hrs</u>: This afternoon, visit the splendid **Agra fort**, built in red sandstone, encapsulating magnificent palaces, halls of public and private audience and beautiful gardens.

<u>18:15 – 19:00 Hrs</u>: Watch a live theatre performance, introducing you to the story of the Taj Mahal. Watch the spectacular performance - "**Mohabbat the Taj – The saga of love**", staging the largest replica of the Taj Mahal, and presenting the legend of love that created this magnificent mausoleum.

Return to your hotel for overnight stay.

24 Aug (Sun) Agra - Jaipur (240 km / 5 hrs) (B/L)

<u>05:30 – 08:00 Hrs</u> (exact sunrise time TBA): Early this morning, witness the surreal views of the **Taj Mahal** by sunrise. Step inside this eternal symbol of love and appreciate the intricate designs and symmetries that rhyme as a poem written in marble. Taj Mahal is an extravagant display of love, built by Shah Jahan in memory of his beloved wife Mumtaz Mahal.

<u>08:00 – 12:00 Hrs</u>: Return back to your hotel in time for breakfast. Relax for some time and check out around noon.

12:00 - 13:30 Hrs: Lunch with brief Hotel Inspection

 $\underline{14:00-19:00~Hrs}$ : Drive to Jaipur – the pink hued capital city of Rajasthan. This city of erstwhile Rajput Maharajas, is built in 9 rectangular sectors symbolising 9 divisions of the universe, as per Indian cosmology. Upon arrival in Jaipur, check in at your hotel for 2 nights stay.

Overnight stay at hotel.

### 25 Aug (Mon) Discover Jaipur (B/L)

07:00 - 08:30 Hrs: Breakfast at hotel

<u>09:00 – 11:30 Hrs</u>: Visit the magnificent **Amber Fort** - built in the 16<sup>th</sup> century, this is one of the most beautiful samples of Rajput architecture, housing a complex of palaces and pavilions, gardens and temples. An elephant ride will help you ascend to this hilltop fort (elephants are subject to availability). Alternatively, you could choose to walk or drive up to the fort.

<u>12:00 – 13:30 Hrs</u>: Lunch with brief Hotel Inspection

<u>14:00 – 17:00 Hrs</u>: This afternoon, visit Jaipur's **City Palace** complex with its various museums where you can see a beautiful collection of Mughal costumes, weapons and miniature paintings. Then visit the fascinating **Jantar Mantar**, the ancient astronomical observatory built by the Maharaja of Jaipur, which is the largest stone observatory in the



world. Also see **Hawa Mahal** (Palace of Winds), built in the 18<sup>th</sup> century. This palace with its innumerable windows and screened balconies was especially built for the royal women to view the city and street processions from behind their 'purdahs' so they remain invisible to the public.

17:00 - 19:00 Hrs: Evening at leisure

26 Aug (Tue) Fly Jaipur – Delhi – Kochi (B)

08:00 - 09:00 Hrs: Breakfast at hotel

09:00 Hrs: Check out and drive to Jaipur airport to catch your flight to Kochi (via Delhi).

<u>13:00 – 15:00 Hrs</u>: Arrive Periyar. Lunch and Hotel Inspection
